

Broad-Leaved Pepper Tree

Scientific Name:

Schinus terebinthifolia

Origin:

Brazil

Habit:

Tree to 10m

Distinguishing Features:

- Leaves compound, (10-20cm) with small wing on central rachis. Leaflet (4-8cm), 5-9, pale green/yellow.
- Flowers small (5mm), white with five petals and yellow anthers. Clustered on branches.
- Fruit berry (5-10mm), bright red when mature.

Control Methods:

- Cut plant to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.
- Stem inject with 100% Glyphosate.
