

Cabomba

Scientific Name:

Cabomba caroliniana

Origin:

North America

Habit:

Aquatic weed

Distinguishing Features:

- *Submerged leaves fine and feather-like (4-7cm), and paired.*
- *Flowers float on surface (10-15mm) on stems with small entire leaves (1-2cm)*

Control Methods:

- *Hard to control.*
- *Impact can be reduced through shading with native vegetation if the water body is small.*
