

Chinese Celtis

Scientific Name:

Celtis sinensis

Origin:

East Asia

Habit:

Tree to 20m

Distinguishing Features:

- Leaves simple, (4-10cm) alternately arranged, glossy green above with bluntly toothed margins
- Flowers small (5mm), greenish, indistinct.
- Fruit a small berry (4.8mm), orange/red when mature.

Control Methods:

- Cut plant to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.
- Stem inject with 100% Glyphosate.
