Distinguishing Features:

- Leaves (8-12cm), dark green and glossy, positioned alternately on branch with a wavy and finely toothed margin.
- Flowers, fragrant, pinkish white with five petals (5-8mm across).
- Fruit (5-10mm), glossy red when mature and clustered.

Control Methods:

- Dig out plant and roots.
- Cut plant to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.
