Shrub 1.5 -2.5m

Distinguishing Features:

- Leaves (5-12cm), simple, positioned alternately on branches. Unpleasant odour when crushed.
- Flowers pale yellow (2cm), long, tubular and clustered.
- Fruit small (10-15mm), egg shaped, black when mature.

Control Methods:

- Dig out plant and roots.
- Cut plant to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.
