

Kahili Ginger

Scientific Name:

Hedychium gardnerianum

Origin:

India—China

Habit:

Perennial Herbaceous Plant

Distinguishing Features:

- Leaves large (20-50cm), alternately arranged and sheathed around the stem at the base.
- Flowers, clustered (20-30cm). Individual flowers yellow, tubular with 3 petals and long red stamen filaments.
- Fruit a three-sided red capsule (10-20mm).

Control Methods:

- Dig out plant and collect the entire rhizome (root).
