

# Madeira Vine

**Scientific Name:**

*Anredera cordifolia*

**Origin:**

South America

**Habit:**

Fleshy Vine

**Distinguishing Features:**

- Leaves heart shaped, simple, fleshy and alternate (5-15cm).
- Flowers, cream coloured (3-5mm) in clusters with 5 petals.
- Conspicuous aerial tubers (potatoes) along stems.

**Control Methods:**

- Scrape (5-10cm) of stem at 3-5 spots and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.
- Spray with Metsulphuron-methyl (Brush-Off) with surfactant.
