

# Orange Jessamine

**Scientific Name:**

*Murraya paniculata*

**Origin:**

*China, South-east Asia and Northern Australia*

**Habit:**

*Shrub 1-4m*

**Distinguishing Features:**

- *Leaves glossy (5-12cm), compound, positioned alternately on branches. Leaflets 3-9.*
- *Flowers white (2cm across), fragrant and clustered*
- *Fruit small (10mm), egg shaped, bright red when mature.*

**Control Methods:**

- *Dig out plant and roots.*
- *Cut plant to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.*
- *Stem inject with 100% Glyphosate.*
