

# Paulownia

## Scientific Name:

*Paulownia tomentosa*

## Origin:

China

## Habit:

Deciduous Tree (10-15m)

## Distinguishing Features:

- Leaves heart shaped (20-30cm), positioned alternately on branches.
- Flowers tubular, mauve (3-5cm across) in large clusters with five petals.
- Fruit four-sided capsule (4-6cm) containing many seeds, yellow/orange when immature drying to a dark brown.

## Control Methods:

- Cut plant to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.
- Stem inject with 100% Glyphosate.
