

Singapore Daisy

Scientific Name:

Sphagneticola trilobata

Origin:

Central America

Habit:

Creeping groundcover

Distinguishing Features:

- Leaves lobed (5-8cm), simple, positioned oppositely and glossy
- Flowers bright yellow (4cm), daisy like appearance.
- Fruit small (2-5mm), indistinct and green.

Control Methods:

- Dig out plant and roots.
- Spray with Metsulphuron-methyl (Brush-Off) 1g per 10 l with surfactant.
