

# White Blackberry

## Scientific Name:

*Rubus niveus*

## Origin:

*Southern Asia*

## Habit:

*Bramble to 2.5m*

## Distinguishing Features:

- *New stems with waxy white coating.*
- *Leaves (12-18cm), compound (7-9 leaflets) and alternately arranged, green above, white below. Lower surface hairy.*
- *Flowers, small (10-15mm), dark pink and clustered.*
- *Fruit a berry (8-12mm), purple/black when mature.*

## Control Methods:

- *Cut plants to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate or Vigilant.*
- *Spray with Metsulphuron Methyl (Brush-off) at 1g per 10 l with surfactant.*
