

# Winter Senna

**Scientific Name:**

*Senna pendula* var. *glabrata*

**Origin:**

South America

**Habit:**

Shrub to 3m

**Distinguishing Features:**

- Leaves compound (5-10cm), alternately arranged, yellow/green with 6-12 leaflets and a blunt rounded tip.
- Flowers, yellow (20-30mm) with 5 petals and two elongated stamens.
- Fruit a capsule (10-15cm), green drying to brown when mature.

**Control Methods:**

- Hand pull seedlings.
- Cut to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.
