

Yellow Bells

Scientific Name:

Tecoma stans

Origin:

Central & South America

Habit:

Shrub to 4m

Distinguishing Features:

- Leaves compound, (10-20cm), oppositely arranged, light green. Leaflets (2-8cm), 3-10, with a toothed margin.
- Flowers, yellow with orange lines and five petals (40mm long).
- Fruit a long capsule (10-20cm), straw coloured when dry

Control Methods:

- Dig out plant and roots.
- Cut plant to ground level and paint immediately with 100% Glyphosate.
- Stem inject with 100% Glyphosate.
