From an open cow paddock and restored back to rainforest.

Come and see what 22 years of rainforest restoration looks like. Dorrigo World Heritage Area Ecological Restoration project has been restoring critically endangered lowland rainforest and habitat for threatened plant and animal species in Gondwana World Heritage area. Dorrigo National Park is home 23 animals and 19 plants that are listed as threatened species.

Learn about the restoration methodology from NPWS and experienced practitioners in what once was an abandoned paddock now being restored to sub-tropical rainforest.
